CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT

You can check in after 15.00, check out time is 12:00. We are flexible if circumstances allow, please check with our team

CAR & MOTORBIKE RENTAL

Our team can assist you in making arrangements for renting a car or motorbike. Please be aware that if you rent a motorbike, you need to have a motorbike drivers license and that the bikes are not insured for damage. This means you will be responsible for any damage. Also: never forget to wear a helmet!

BANK, ATM & MONEY CHANGER

BANK The closest bank is in Sumberkima, approximately 10 minutes away. It is open from Mo-Fri 8:00 - 16:00

ATM There are multiple ATM machines in Pemuteran.

MONEY CHANGER There is a money changer located in Pemuteran.

DEPARTMENT // AIRPORT INFORMATION

Please plan to arrive at the airport at least 2 hours prior to an international departure and 1 hour for a domestic departure. Please let our team know if you want us to arrange your transport to the airport or another location. The rate per car for 4 people to the south is Rp 800.000 for a luxury car.

STORES

There are some small shops and supermarkets located on the main road. The traditional Goris market is a few kilometers away towards Gili-manuk. In Pemuteran you will find more shops and souvenir shops.

SECURITY

Security guards are on duty from 19.00 until 07.00. Staff is present 24/7 so the compound is always guarded.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

If you need medical assistance we can have a doctor on call. Please contact our team. We have a first-aid kit at the front office.

SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNT

Accounts can be settled with our team at the villa. You can use cash or credit card. Our machine is suitable for Master and Visa cards. We charge a 2.25% credit card fee.

PRACTICAL INFO

AIR CONDITIONING

Please conserve energy and use the air conditioning wisely. Switch off the air-conditioning in the morning and turn it on 15 minutes before you go to bed. We recommend a programmed temperature of 26 °C at night. If you require assistance with adjustments, please contact our staff.

INTERNET ACCESS

WiFi is available via a modem through which we can offer you X MB internet per day. The staff will provide you with login details. In Bali, good internet is difficult to find and is mostly very slow. On the bright side, that offers you an opportunity to put down your phone for a few days and completely relax & recharge!

TV

In the lounge we have a TV with satellite connection.

SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX

You may place your valuables in the safety deposit box located in the individual rooms.

WATER

We have a tap in the kitchen and will refill the carafes in the bathroom with clean & fresh water every day. Let's try to use less plastic together!

LAUNDRY & IRONING

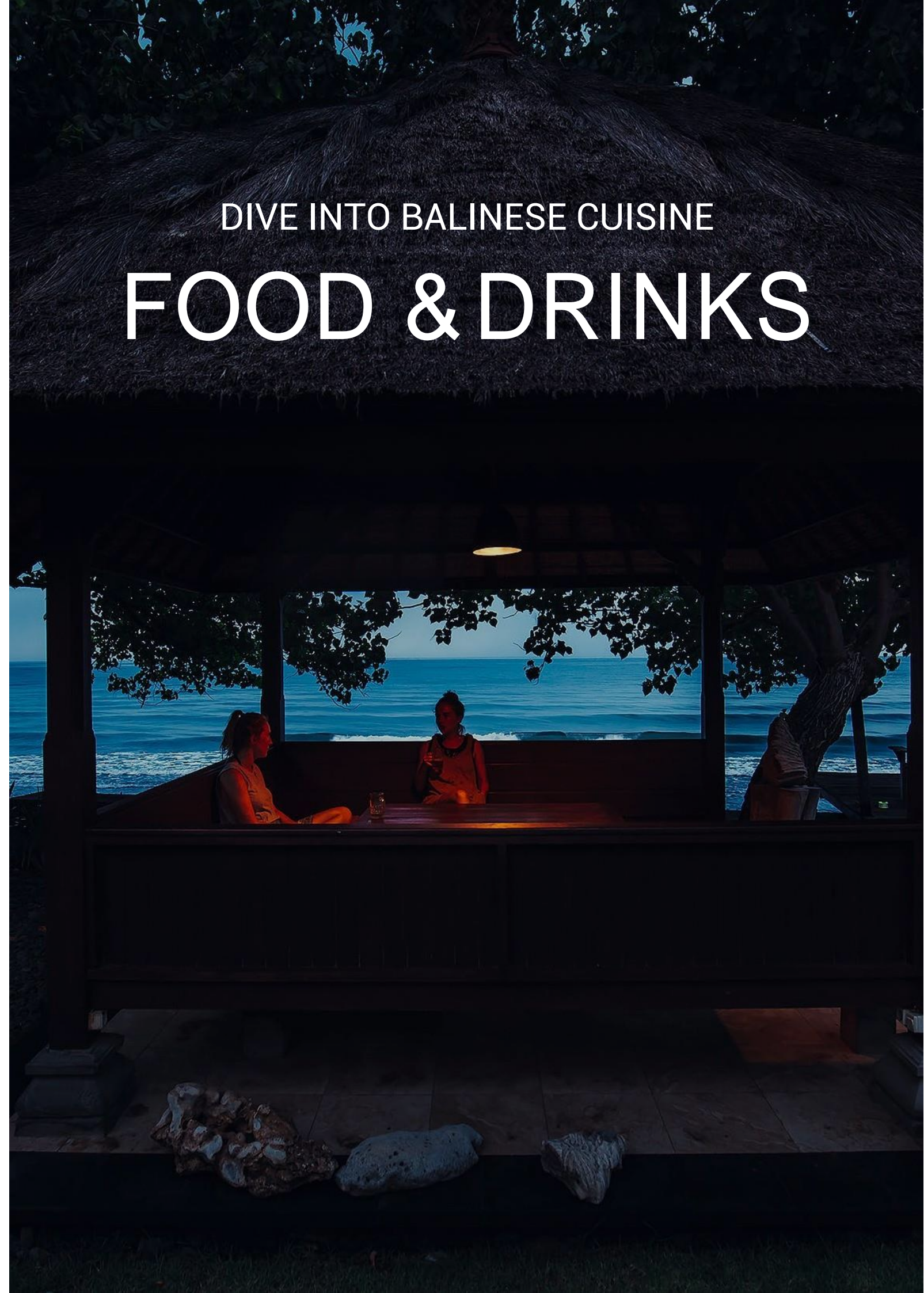
There is laundry service available please ask a team member.

SUMA RESTAURANT

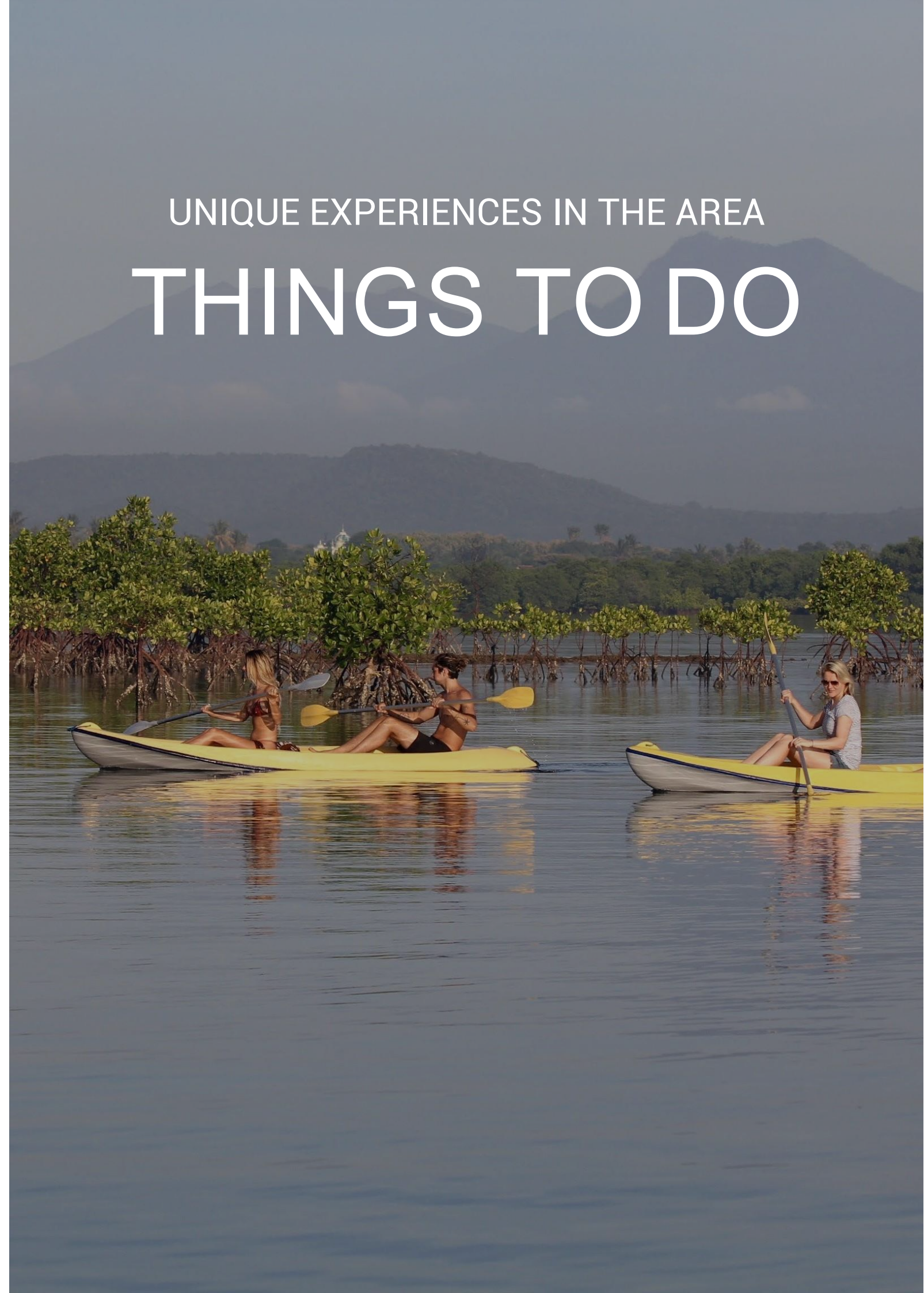

A TRADITIONAL BOAT TRIP

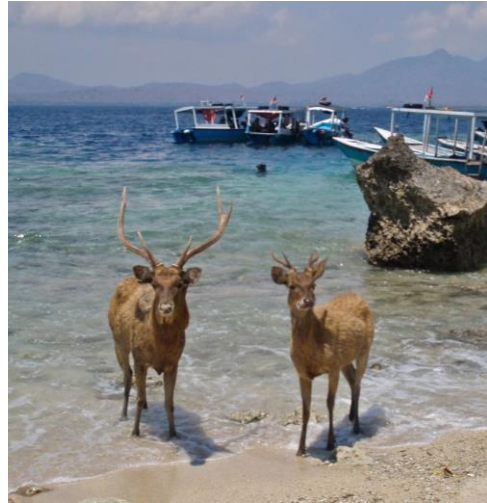

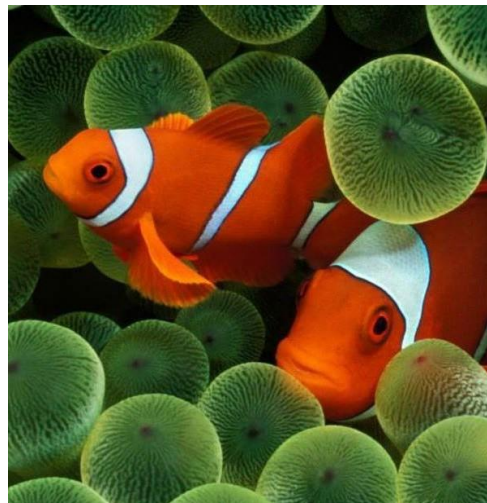


MENJANGAN ISLAND

at Barat National Park, +/- 30 km from Villa Semadhi

Just off the North West coast lies Pulau Menjangan (Deer Island); an uninhabited island, surrounded by coral reef. The island is situated in the protected marine reserve of the Barat National Park and has a diverse eco biology. Most visitors rate this as the best snorkeling spot in Bali and divers place it high on their list too. There are no dangerous currents in this area. Our team can arrange the transport, permits and obligatory guides to enter the National Park.

PEMUTERAN REEF

in Pemuteran Bay, 2,5 km from Villa Semadhi

Pemuteran Bay has the largest area of shallow reefs in Bali. The region lacks the strong currents and waves that characterize other coastal areas of Bali. That makes it an ideal spot for diving and snorkeling. There are several diving and snorkeling locations. Napoleon Reef and Close Encounters are very nice options. They're located about 15 minutes by boat.



BIOROCK

in Pemuteran Bay, 2,5 km from Villa Semadhi

Pemuteran uses electricity to stimulate the growth of new coral. More than 115 Biorock coral nursery structures have been installed since June 2000. With a total length of a few hundred meters, this is one of the largest Biorock restoration projects worldwide. These structures are located about 50-100 meters from the coastline and form a natural snorkelling and diving trail.



KAYAK & BOAT TRIPS WITH METAMORFOSA

in Sumberkima Bay, 10 km from Villa Semadhi

Metamorfosa is an NGO project in the next bay. Their mission is to create a healthy eco-system by restoring the reef and reforesting the hills. There is a reef restoration project with an underwater art gallery and several forms of sustainable marine farming. The bay is lined with mangroves and a backdrop of mountains and volcanoes. It has large shallow reefs and a white sand island. You can explore this area by kayak or organize a boat trip to snorkel at the reef.

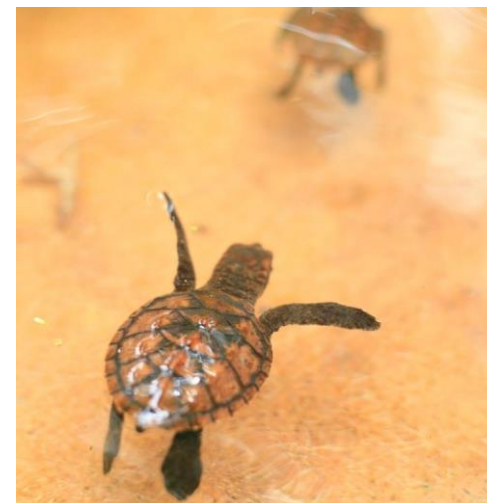

TURTLE CONSERVATION PROJECT PERANCAK

in Perancah, 70 km from Villa Semadhi

Perancah Beach is the nesting site for a variety of sea turtles specie: mostly the Olive Ridley turtle, the Leatherback turtle and the Hawksbill turtle. The perfect time of the year to visit is from April to September, when the turtles come to lay their eggs. The nesting season is a busy time for local fishermen, including Kurma Asih, who tries to save the eggs from poachers. He will proudly explain to you how it all works and will kindly ask you to make a small donation. Then you can release some baby turtles at the beach. A great experience!



TURTLE HATCHERY IN PEMUTERAN

in Pemuteran, 2,5 km from Villa Semadhi

At Pemuteran Beach you will find a turtle hatchery at Reef Seen. Their purpose is to protect the sea turtles to increase the chances for turtle hatchlings to reach maturity. They buy newly laid eggs from locals who find a nest. By doing so they encourage villagers not to kill or capture mature turtles. The hatchlings are protected at Reef Seen until they are bigger and have a greater chance of survival in the open sea. Depending on the season they have eggs from three different species of sea turtles: Green turtle, Olive Ridley and Hawksbill. For a small donation you can hear their story. You can also sponsor and release a juvenile turtle for which you will receive a certificate of recognition.

CULTURE: TEMPLES & CEREMONIES

NOTE: Tourists are obliged to wear a sarong or scarf to enter the area around the temple.



TEMPLE TOURS

There are some very interesting temples in the area. Some temples are close to each other and easy to combine, like the Belatung, Kerta Kawat and Melanting temple. The temple tour offers a nice walk in the area where you can watch the cultivation process and harvest grapes in the vineyards, if in season. Please ask our teams if you would like to experience a temple tour.



THE PULAKI, PABEAN & SEGARA TEMPLE

in Pemuteran, 500 m from Villa Semadhi

This is a trio of temples nestled between the mountains and the sea. Balinese believe there is a special energy where the mountains almost touch the sea. They call it *Nyegara Gunung*. Backed up against the hills, Pura Pulaki is the main temple for Pemuteran. Across the road you'll find Pura Pabean, where local fishermen come to pray for safe journeys. At the foot of Pura Pabean, next to the sea is a very basic and much older temple known as Pura Segara.



PEMUTERAN TEMPLE

in Pemuteran, 2 km from Villa Semadhi

On a small side street of the main road in Pemuteran you can find the Pemuteran Temple, also called "hot spring temple" with holy water from a source inside the temple. During full moon, many Balinese come to pray here.



MELANTING TEMPLE

in Pemuteran, 3,5 km from Villa Semadhi

Pura Melanting is a place for traders and businessmen to ask for fortune and good luck. It has a rich, historical architecture and a very special location. Dating back to the 15th century, it is located on the slopes of Mount Pulaki and is surrounded by tropical forests and local vineyards. Late afternoon (around 5 pm) is normally the best time to visit.



PUNCAK MANIK TEMPLE

in Pemuteran, 4 km from Villa Semadhi

Behind Pura Melanting you can find the Puncak Manik temple. A small temple, built around a sacred spring, high up in the hills. You have to climb hundreds of steps, but when you have reached the top, you are rewarded by a magnificent view.



BELATUNG TEMPLE

in Pemuteran, 5 km from Villa Semadhi

The Belatung temple is a beautiful jungle temple; the scenery and atmosphere are excellent for meditation. The temple is located in Banyupoh with an unspoiled view of nature. It has vineyards around the temple.

HIKES, DAY TRIPS & WATERFALLS



KERTA KAWAT TEMPLE

in Pemuteran, 3,5 km from Villa Semadhi

Situated majestically on the foot of a hill, Kerta Kawat is a pilgrim place for people who want to get an advance in their career. Balinese believe that praying at this temple will further increase prosperity. From Kerta Kawat you will have beautiful views on the blue ocean and the strong green mountains of Bali Barat National Park.



TRADITIONAL BALINESE DANCING

in Pemuteran, 2,5 km from Villa Semadhi

Dancing is an important part of Balinese culture. At Reef Seen, they help the children of Pemuteran carry on this beautiful tradition. Young girls and boys gather here twice a week to train with the older, more experienced dancers. Guests are welcome to join the dancers!

On Saturday evenings at 7 pm you can watch the dance group perform at Reef Seen. You can also watch the practice sessions on Saturday and Sunday from 3 pm to 5 pm. Inquire with our team if you want to organize a private show at the villa.



ALING ALING WATERFALLS

in Pemuteran, 55 km from Villa Semadhi

The Aling Aling waterfall is located in Sambangan village, about 1,5 hours from Pemuteran. On your way to the waterfall you will see beautiful rice paddies. The fresh crystal clear water from the mountain and the surrounding green sceneries will make you feel close to nature. If you dare, you can go sliding on a natural slide or jumping (a 10-12 and 16 meter jump) in the natural pool. It's fun, challenging and refreshing!



SEKUMPUL WATERFALLS

in Pemuteran, 73 km from Villa Semadhi

One of the tallest and most beautiful waterfalls in Bali, the Sekumpul waterfall, is located in Sekumpul village. You have to walk quite a few steps down and up but the views are spectacular! You will find many fruit trees along the way.

You also have to wade through some water to reach the falls and you can swim around its base. A paradise for trekkers and adventure seekers, there are 7 waterfalls and several tracks in the area from 2 to 5 hours.



SUNSET & MOONRISE FROM MOUNT BERATAN

in Pemuteran, 4 km from Villa Semadhi

After a 60 minute walk, you can reach the peak of this small mountain. Here you will find a meditation center. From this point you can see a magnificent view of the ocean and mountain forest as well as a splendid sunset over the volcanoes of East Java. During full moon, it is possible to see the sun setting and full moon rising at the same time.



BALI BARAT NATIONAL PARK WALK

in Bali Barat National Park, 30 km from Villa Semadhi

Bali Barat National Park is mountainous and consists of primary monsoon forest, mangrove forest, lowland rain forest, savanna, sea grass vegetation types, coral reefs, sandy beaches and both shallow and deep sea waters. A guided trek through the park is a special back-to-nature adventure. Experienced national park guides can take you on an easy journey through the areas and explain about the local flora and fauna.



UBUD DAY TRIP

in Ubud, +/-100 km from Villa Semadhi

A full day trip starting at 08.00. You can visit the Beratan Lake, Mengwi Temple, Batubulan (traditional batik village), Celuk (silver village), Batuan (painting village), Mas (wood carving village) and many more beautiful places in the Ubud area. Please discuss your preferred trip with our team.



MUNDUK DAY TRIP

in Munduk, +/-50 km from Villa Semadhi

A trip to Munduk takes you into the mountains surrounded by the three lakes: Buyan, Tamblingan and Bratan. You can visit the coffee & cloves plantations and rice fields and end up at the beautiful Munduk waterfalls. At Lake Buyan you'll find the famous Ulun Danu temple that is portrayed in many travel books about Bali. This area offers stunning scenery and is perfect for hikes and walks.



KINTAMANI DAY TRIP

in Kintamani, +/-100 km from Villa Semadhi

A full day trip starting at 07.30. You can visit the Beji Temple, Coffee Plantation in Sebatu Village, Tegalalang rice terraces, Beratan Lake and many more beautiful places in the Kintamani area. Please discuss your preferred trip with our team.



MUNDUK & JATILUWIH DAY TRIP

in Munduk // Jatiluwih, 50 // 90 km from Villa Semadhi

A full day tour starting at 08.00, customized to your wishes. You can visit the Munduk waterfalls, twin lakes (Buyan & Tamblingan lake), the Bratan temple, Baturiti coffee & cloves plantation, Jatiluwih rice terrace, the Batukaru temple, Butterfly park and Pupuan. You can discuss your preferred trip with our team.



PERANCAK JUKUNG

in Perancah, 70 km from Villa Semadhi

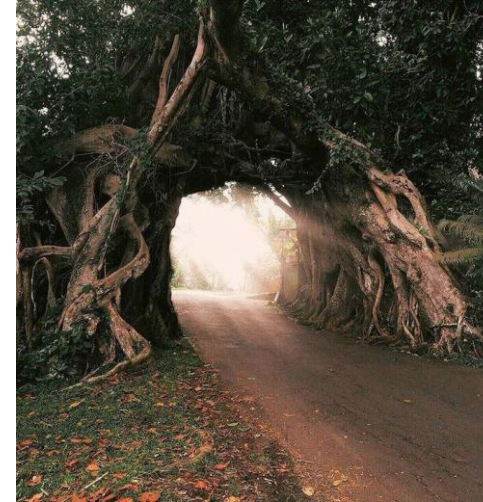
On the Perancah river an amazing sight of the traditional jukung and sampans boats can be seen quietly resting on the river. If you can find a boatsman, ask for a ride on a jukung and have a ride to the mangroves. Our driver has contacts there.



PALASARI CHURCH

in Palasari, 50 km from Villa Semadhi

Surrounded by the forest and coconut plantations, Palasari can be reached within one hour drive from Pemuteran. In this village you can find the Catholic church established in 1940. The word "palasari" is derived from the word "pala" meaning "nutmeg" and the word "sari" meaning "essence". The church architecture is a mixture of Gothic and Balinese traditional architecture, symbolizing the harmonious relation of Hindus and Catholics in Bali. Next to the Church you can see the water dam called Bendungan Palasari which is the largest water dam in Bali.



THE BUNUT BOLONG TREE

in Manggissari, 60 km from Villa Semadhi

The Bunut Bolong Tree is a huge banyan tree, unique, because you can drive through the tree with a car. You can find this huge tree in Desa Manggisari/Pekutatan.



BRAHMA VIHARA

in Banjar, +/-40 km from Villa Semadhi

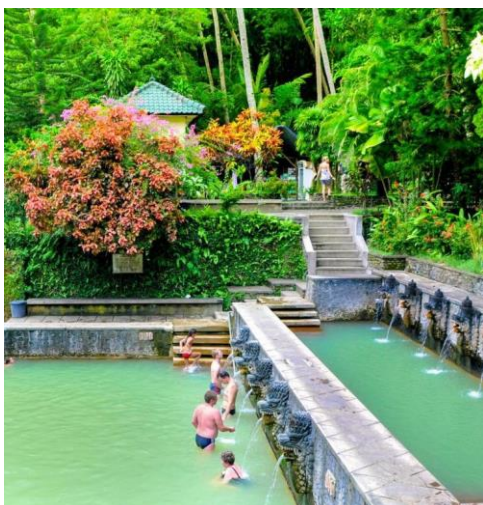
Brahma Vihara Arama is 10 minutes from Banjar Hot Spring. This is the biggest ashram for Buddhists in Bali. The monastery provides you a breathtaking view and serene and peaceful surroundings. You can also admire a temple inspired by the famous Borobudur. An excellent example of how two religions have intertwined here.



SURFING IN MEDEWI

in Medewi, 80 km from Villa Semadhi

If you would like to go surfing, the closest option is Medewi beach, about 1,5 hours from Villa Semadhi. Medewi is an enchanting spot in West Bali that catches great waves but also has a laidback vibe and is a great place to relax.



BANJAR HOT SPRING

in Banjar, +/-40 km from Villa Semadhi

Banjar hot spring is not far from the Buddhist temple Brahma Vihara. This ancient looking hot spring is set in a beautiful flowered garden. There are three baths where you can puddle in 38°C sulphur water. The hot springs were made by the Japanese hundreds of years ago. There are carved stone dragons pouring water into the pools. Traditional belief holds that this hot spring can cure illness, eliminate the feeling of stress and provides relaxation.

NOTE: It can get crowded during Balinese Holidays.



CLIMBING KAWAH IJEN

in East Java, 70 km from Villa Semadhi

Kawah Ijen (2,600m) on Eastern Java has breathtaking views, a turquoise-colored acid crater lake and active sulphur mine. The trek is about 3 km of which only 1.5km is a bit of a steep climb. The path is marked and on the way you will come across a former volcanology viewing post that serves drinks. During the climb, you will meet sulphur miners displaying great strength, balance and work ethics as they go about their business. To be able to see the blue flames in the crater you should leave at 23:00. Your approximate arrival time back in Pemuteran will be 11 o'clock in the morning. You can discuss this trip with our team.



DOLPHIN WATCHING IN LOVINA

in Lovina, 30 km from Villa Semadhi

Every morning at sunrise dozens of dolphins gather just offshore of Lovina beach. At 6 o'clock in the morning you can take a local boat to see the dolphins. The dolphin watching trip is for min. 2 people.

NOTE: Dolphins are intelligent and curious - and encounters that take place on *their* terms, not ours - are more memorable! Your skipper should always approach dolphins slowly and never from the front or rear and boats should slow down when dolphins are spotted. Lovina is known for its large amount of tourists and it can be quite busy at sea with many dolphin watching trips at the same time. If this doesn't feel right, we recommend skipping this trip.
